## STEP 3: Administer Diagnostic/Survey-Level Assessments as Needed\*\*

\*\*The purpose of Diagnostic Assessment is to collect any additional information necessary to guide instruction/intervention in the targeted area: Basic Reading, Reading Fluency, Reading Comprehension, Written Expression, Math Calculation, or Math Problem-Solving. This step also includes screening with out-of-grade FAST Curriculum-Based Measures when needed to establish baselines for progress monitoring.
